Who can apply?

To be considered for the scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

Enrolled in a foundational program and/or an apprenticeship program to obtain the skills required to become a certified Motorsports/Marine technician at any Canadian college, university, or post-secondary trade school for the **Fall 2025** or **Winter 2026** academic year.

NOTE

- Employees of Yamaha Motor Canada Ltd. and/or Yamaha Motor Finance Canada Ltd., and/or Yamaha Dealers are eligible to apply for this scholarship.
- Family members of Yamaha Motor Canada Ltd.'s employees and/or Yamaha Motor Finance Canada Ltd., employees and/or Yamaha Dealer employees are eligible to apply for this scholarship.
- While it is not a requirement to be a dependent and/or current employee of Yamaha Motor Canada Ltd., or Yamaha Motor Finance Canada Ltd., or a Yamaha Dealer, you will need to have your application sponsored either by your local Yamaha Dealership (by the principal or owner at the Dealership) or by a representative of Yamaha Motor Canada Ltd.

Applications will **NOT** be considered if the criteria indicated above are **NOT** met.

Scholarships

We will be offering a total of two (2) scholarships for Technicians:

• Two (2) \$2,500 scholarships for those pursuing their Marine and/or Motorsports Technician qualifications





Required Documents

- 1. A completed application form submitted by end of day (EOD) June 6, 2025 (ET) to dealertraining@yamaha-motor.ca.
- 2. A transcript from the last two (2) semesters from either a high school or post-secondary institution. A copy of the transcript is acceptable—does not need to be an official transcript.
- 3. Proof of enrolment in a Canadian post-secondary institution for **the Fall 2025 or Winter 2026 academic year**. **Important:** Proof of enrolment in a previous semester is not acceptable. One (1) of the following is acceptable:
 - Letter of acceptance
 - Proof of tuition payment
 - · Letter from Office of Registrar

NOTE: If proof of enrolment for a **Fall 2025 or Winter 2026 academic year course/program** is not available by the application deadline, please indicate in your application when you expect to receive your confirmation of enrolment. Successful applicants will not receive their scholarship cheques without submitting proof of enrolment.

- 4. Letter of Recommendation from a teacher/instructor/manager. The letter should speak to why you are worthy of this scholarship. Points to consider for the letter are your academic achievements, natural ability, hard work, professionalism, teamwork, attention to detail, initiatives etc.
- 5. Your Presentation (2 4 minutes in length **OR** 600 800 words):

Tell us about you! Be sure to include the following in your presentation:

- Introduce yourself (be sure to include your name)
- Tell us why you need a Yamaha Technician scholarship—and how you would benefit from a Yamaha scholarship
- How your passion for Marine and/or Motorsports products has led you to pursue a career as a certified technician

Presentation Requirements

- While you may use the application form to tell us about you; we encourage all applicants to use a combination of videos, text, images and/or animations to do so—this will help to set you apart and showcase what makes you uniquely you
- Presentation submission should be between 2 4 minutes in length or 600 800 words
- · Please have as minimal background noise as possible
- All sources must be cited—no uncopyrighted material (music, images, etc.)
- Presentation / video (if filmed), must be filmed horizontally (Wide screen/16:9/Landscape)
- Presentation should be .pptx, .docx, .mp4, .mov or .avi file types only
- Presentation must be able to play on both Mac and PC Platforms
- Speak slowly, clearly and show enthusiasm
- Suggested programs to create a presentation: PowerPoint, Word, iMovie, Windows Media Player, to name a few
- To prevent any challenges with the submission of your application due to file size, we recommend that videos be uploaded to a private/unlisted YouTube channel and the link shared within the application

Application Deadline and Announcement of Winner

Applications must be sent via email to dealertraining@yamaha-motor.ca and must be received by no later than end of day (EOD) June 9, 2023 (ET). Late applications will NOT be considered.

Once successful applicants are notified, an announcement will be released on Yamaha Motor Canada's internal site and via social media.
