Tim Kryski Scholarship Application Process

Who can apply?

To be considered for the scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Anyone currently residing in Newfoundland and Labrador.
- Note: children of Yamaha Motor Canada Ltd., and/or Yamaha Motor Finance Canada Ltd., employees and/or authorized Yamaha Dealers residing in Newfoundland and Labrador are also eligible to apply.
- Enrolled full-time at any Canadian College, University, or post-secondary trade school for **Fall/Winter 2025 – 2026 academic year**, which includes co-op/practicum/placements etc. The College/University/Trade school can be out of province.
- Students can be in any year of their college or post-secondary trade school.

If you do not meet these criteria, your application will **NOT** be considered.

Past Winners and Repeat Applicants

Repeat applications will be considered if the eligibility requirements listed under “Who can apply?” are met. All repeat applicants are encouraged to show their progression since the previous year and are reminded to send updated documents (current enrolment information, copy of your most recent transcript), in addition to all other required information.

Required Documents

1. A completed application form submitted by **end of day (EOD) June 6, 2025 (ET)** to dealertraining@yamaha-motor.ca.
2. A transcript from the last two (2) semesters from either a high school or post-secondary institution. A copy of the transcript is acceptable—does not need to be an official transcript.
3. Proof of enrolment in a Canadian post-secondary institution for the **Fall/Winter 2025 – 2026 academic year**.
Important: Proof of enrolment in a previous semester is not acceptable. One (1) of the following is acceptable:
 - Letter of acceptance
 - Proof of tuition payment
 - Letter from Office of Registrar

NOTE: If proof of enrolment in a **Fall/Winter 2025 – 2026 academic year** is not available by the application deadline, please indicate in your application when you expect to receive your confirmation of enrolment. Successful applicants will not receive their scholarship cheques without submitting proof of enrolment.

4. A 200 words (max) reference letter from **ONE** of the following employer / teacher / sponsor that includes the following:
 - How the applicant demonstrates their commitment to the Powersports industry
 - Ways in which the applicant has distinguished himself/herself/themselves from their peers
 - Reasons indicating why the applicant is deserving of the Tim Kryski Scholarship
 - Employer/Teacher/Sponsor contact information

- Presentation submission should be between 2 – 4 minutes in length or 600 – 800 words
- Please have as minimal background noise as possible
- All sources must be cited—no uncopyrighted material (music, images, etc.)
- Presentation / video (if filmed), must be filmed horizontally (Wide screen/16:9/Landscape)
- Presentation should be .pptx, .docx, .mp4, .mov or .avi file types only
- Presentation must be able to play on both Mac and PC Platforms
- Speak slowly, clearly and show enthusiasm
- Suggested programs to create a presentation: PowerPoint, Word, iMovie, Windows Media Player, to name a few
- To prevent any challenges with the submission of your application due to file size, we recommend that videos be uploaded to a private/unlisted YouTube channel and the link shared within the application
